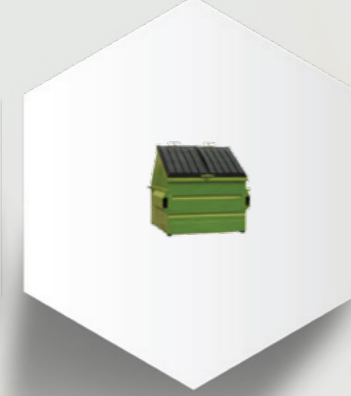

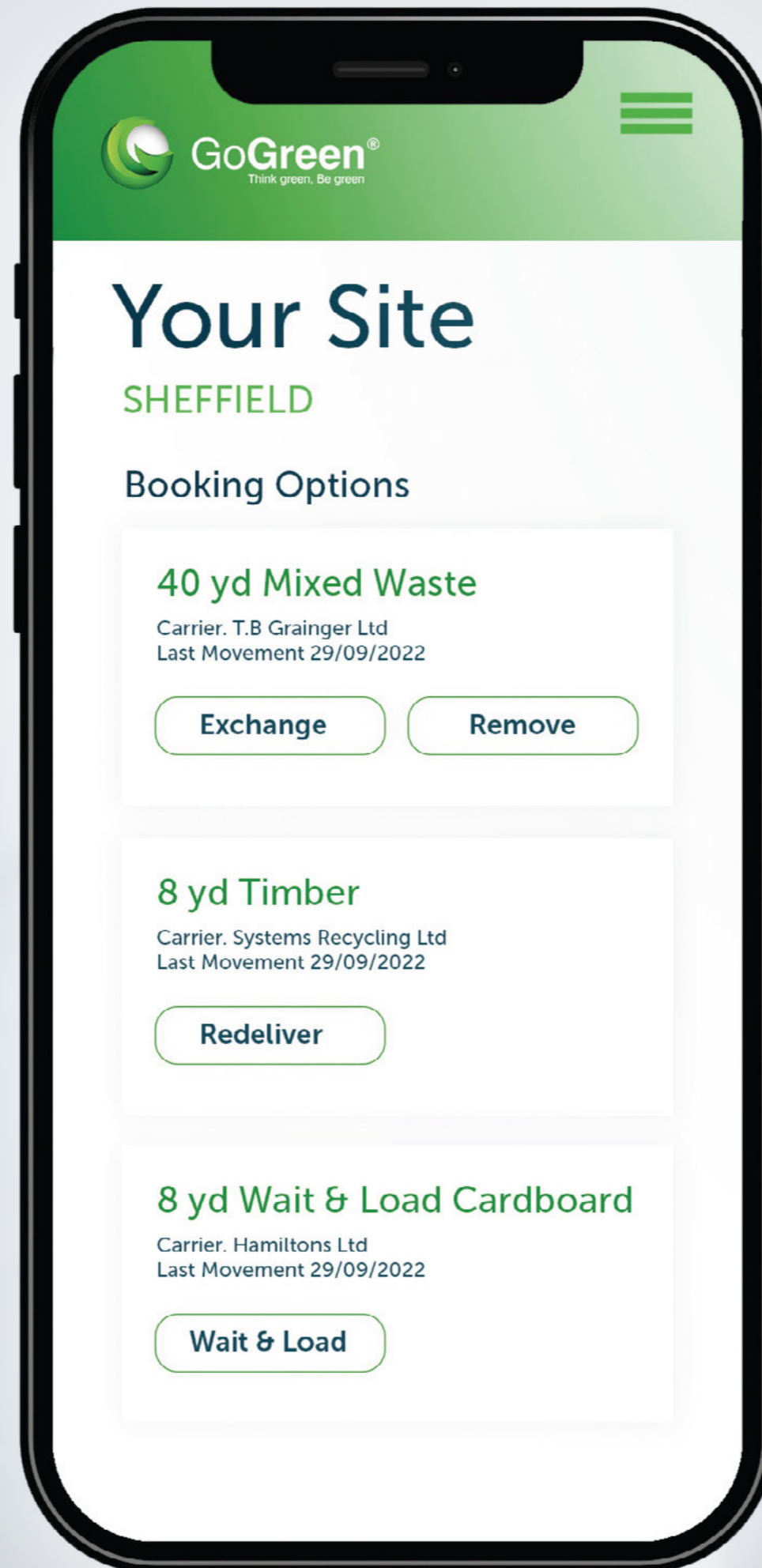
Expectations of waste management, like everything else, have evolved as technology strives forward; that's why Go Green developed, and launched, our WasteLink App which increases convenience for businesses.

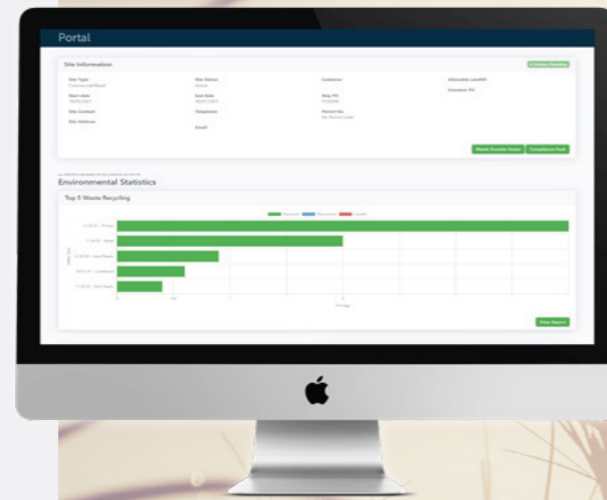

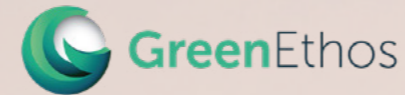
Our GROWW Strategy

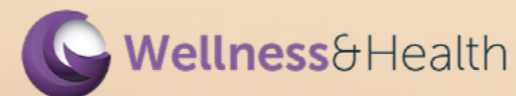
Inspiring the next generation to understand environmental issues, interact with the waste industry, and form their own ideas about their future impact.

With our customer's compliance at the forefront of our delivered services, it's vital that we pay close attention to the 3,000+ suppliers in our database. Our robust supplier approval process ensures our customers receive quality service in line with current legislation and best practice.

From site visits, to EA checks, compliance packs to waste transfer notes, Go Green manage the whole process and collate the information into our online customer portal for ease of access. By logging into the portal, all supplier licences and insurances can be viewed and downloaded when necessary.

Suppliers are categorised based on their service, recycling rates, audit trails and weight breakdowns; suppliers are then matched to customers based on the requirements of the job.
